Graham County, Arizona.

SOLOMONVILLE, ARIZ., July 17th, 1901.

Board met pursuant to adjournment.

Present, W. R. Waddill, chairman; Henry Hill and Ira Harper, supervisors; Thomas Smith, clerk; P. C. Merrill, assessor.

Minutes of the session of July 16th were read and approved.

On petition and on motion, by a full vote of the Board, school districts Nos 35 and 36 in the county of Graham are hereby created and established with boundaries as follows, viz:

No. 35, beginning about five miles south of Squaw creek on the Blue River, thence east to the territorial line, thence south on said line to a point due east of where Sardine creek intersects San Francisco river, thence due west to Eagle creek, thence northerly along Eagle creek to a point due west of point of beginning; thence east to point of beginning.

No. 36, beginning at northeast corner of section 13 in township 7, south of range 25 east G. & S. R. M; thence due west to one-fourth mile west of section 16 in said township and range; thence south to crest of Mount Graham, thence along said crest of Mount Graham easterly to the west line of district No. 34; thence due north to point of beginning.

On motion and by a full vote of the Board, it is hereby ordered that the taxes for the year 1899 against L. Barney, erroneously levied, are hereby remitted.

On motion unanimously carried, it is hereby ordered that the taxes for the year 1899 against E. S. Carpenter, be and are hereby reduced to \$32.53, part of the assessment having been erroneously levied.

On motion unanimously carried it is hereby ordered that the taxes for the year 1901 against I. B. Elmer and A. O. Lamereaux, be and are hereby released from payment they having shown to the Board to be invalids and unable to pay the amount charged against them.

On motion unanimously carried, it is hereby ordered that the taxes for the years 1897, 1898, 1899 and 1900, be and are hereby reduced \$51.50, and the balance due is hereby accepted from J. E. Knudson and tax deed ordered to be issued to said J. E. Knudson.

On motion and by a full vote of the Board, the assignment of school land lease for lands in section 16, township 7 south of range 27 east I. E. Solomon to William Johns is hereby authorized.

In the year 1897, 4 lots in block 46 Safford, assessed to W. E. Jones by a clerical error, the tax collector sold these lots as in block 46 Pima. On motion unanimously carried, it is hereby ordered that the clerk make the correction on tax deed in his office, the taxes having him paid in full by S. S. Marshall and W. T. Webb for the year 1897.

On motion unanimously carried it is hereby ordered that the taxes for the year 1899 against C. E. Willbank and Miss Ruby Heller were erroneously levied, are hereby remitted.

On motion and by a full vote of the Board, the following claims

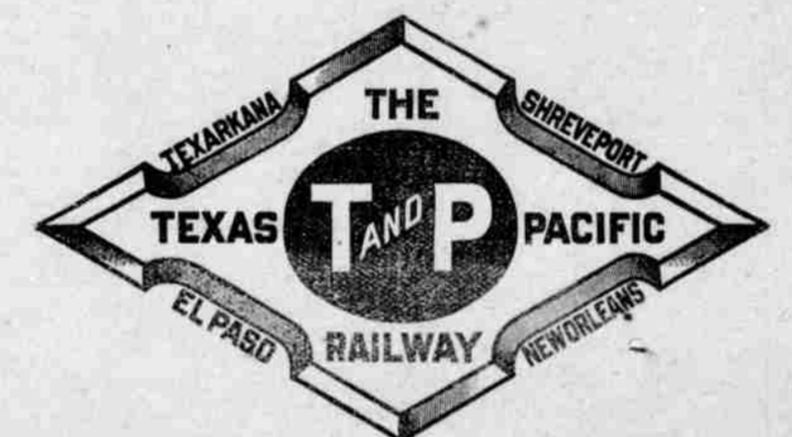
