In the first place, I nominate and appoint Jean Paterson my beloved wife to be my sole Executor during her life, and James Paterson and Jean Paterson, my son and daughter and the survivor and acceptor of them, to be my sole Executors or Executor after her decease; with power to give up Inventories and exercise all the rights and privileges of that Office. Second I leave and bequeath to my said wife in lifetime for her lifetime use at least, the whole of my moveable property of every description including the Stock, Crops, and other effects which at the time of my death I may leave on or belonging to my said Farm of Langfords. Third On the decease of my said wife or in the event of her purchasing me, on my decease I direct my said moveable estate and Effects to be divided into eight equal parts or shares, and to be paid and conveyed over as follows videlicet Three of said parts to James Paterson my son, and the remaining three parts to my daughter Jean Paterson; But desiring as it is hereby specially provided and declared, that the Stock, Crops, and other Effects on my said Farm are not to be so divided and paid away before the time of the Lease I now hold - all as hereinafter

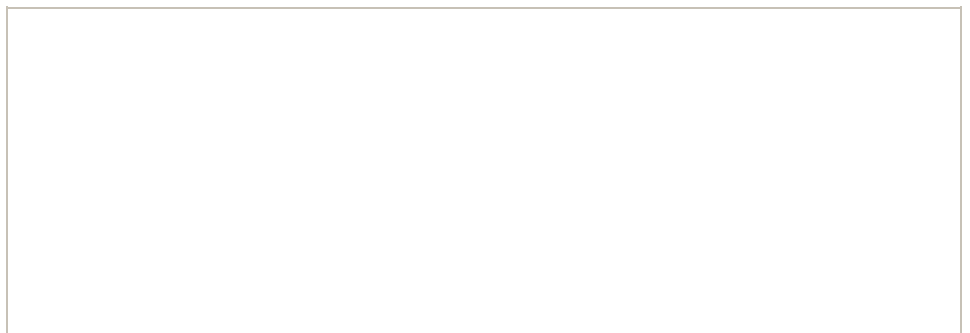

At Amman the Twenty eighth day of July Eighteen hundred and seventy years. In presence of James Scott Skelton, one of Her Majesty's Justices of the peace for the County of Dumfries. Appears the Sean Paterson residing at Longfords in the Parish of Coonstruction, Co. Dumfries of the deceased James Paterson, Farmer there, who being solemnly sworn and examined deposes that the said James Paterson died at Longfords aforesaid upon the seventh day of January Eighteen hundred and sixty nine and the Deponent has entered upon the possession and management of the deceased Estate as Executor nominated by him along with James Paterson and Sean Paterson his son and daughter executor nominated by him after the decease of his Deponent in a general Settlement executed by him upon the thirteenth day of January Eighteen hundred and sixty two, which is now exhibited and signed by the Deponent and the said James Scott Skelton of this date as relative hereto. That the Deponent does not know of any Testamentary Settlement or Writing relative to the disposal of the deceased's personal Estate or Effects or any part thereof other than the said Settlement: That the foregoing Inventory signed by the Deponent and the said James Scott Skelton as relative hereto is a full and complete Inventory of the deceased's Estate and Effects.

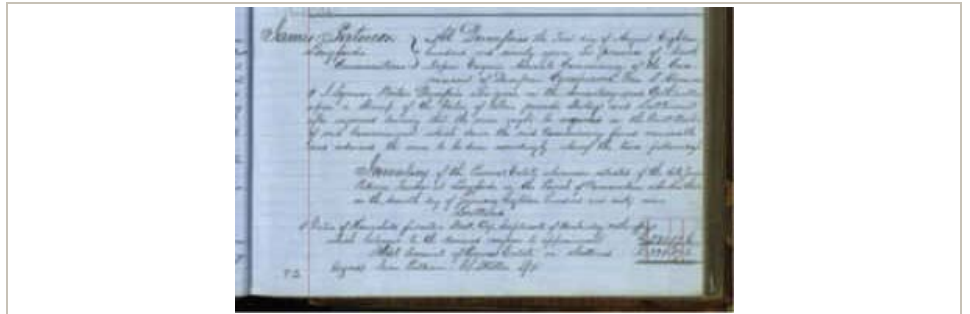
